

Vintage Thunderbird 2005 Contract

This agreement is made this ____th day of _____, 2005, between VINTAGE THUNDERBIRD, hereinafter referred to as Performer and _____ hereinafter referred to as Sponsor.

Performer agrees to provide Lockheed T-33 for the Friday afternoon press show and (2) weekend aerobatic performances for a fee of \$_____. After each acro performance, Performer agrees to: recover aircraft to show center; have the pilots meet the public & autograph show programs; and other reasonable promotional duties as requested by Sponsor.

Performer also agrees to place the aircraft on static display when it is not in conflict with the aerobatic performances. While on static display, Performer will have at least one pilot available to meet with the public. If a suitable step/platform is provided by Sponsor, aircraft cockpit for viewing while on static display.

The airshow will be held at _____ on _____, 2005. Payment of 20% (\$_____), will be made to Vintage Thunderbird as a non-refundable deposit to guarantee the booking. Upon completion of the contract, Vintage Thunderbird will be paid the remaining 80% (\$_____) due on the contract. The advance booking will be held until ___/___/____. After that date, receipt of the deposit is required to guarantee the airshow booking.

Performer will not be held responsible for events beyond his control that prevent the performance, and in such an event the sponsor's deposit will be fully refunded. In the event runway length/temperatures prevent full departure fuel, Sponsor agrees to reimburse Performer at Sponsor's cost/gallon for any fuel not loaded on departure from allotment. The Sponsor also agrees to provide the following to the Performer at no cost:

1. 1200 gallons Jet A/JP8 departure fuel allotment
2. fuel: 250 gals/show & smoke oil (Corvis/Canopus 13): 52 gals/show
3. 2 motel rooms (a single room for each pilot)
4. 1 courtesy car
